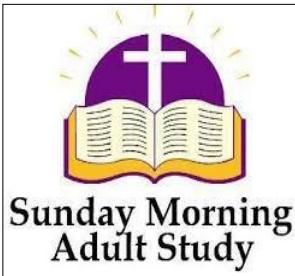

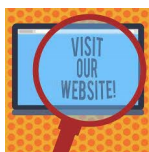
Park Lake Children on Sundays
