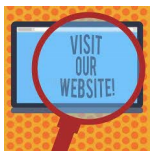
Park Lake Children on Sundays

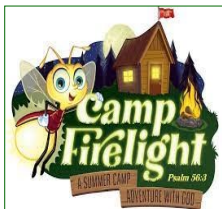
Please see an Usher if you need assistance. Our nursery caregiver is Barbara Boyce.
