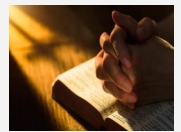

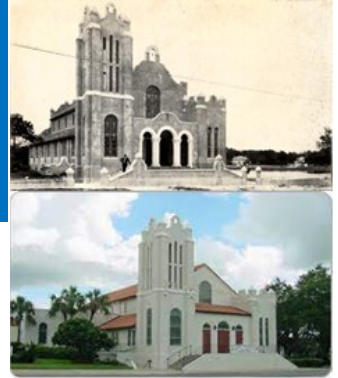


THE POTTER'S HAND: Combining Art and Faith
