
100th Anniversary Architectural Tour

Park Lake's Original Church Organ

The original 1925 church organ was a 13 rank instrument, installed by the Pilcher Organ Company. Each rank had 61 pipes, so the organ system included 793 pipes made of metal and wood. In the 1970s, another 32 ranks (1952 pipes) were added. Later updates included purchasing a digital organ and connecting it to the pipe organ. Maintenance is ongoing.


The **Gay Straight@Park Lake** group will be collecting gift cards and monetary contributions for **Zebra Youth**

FINANCIAL GIVING DIRECTLY FROM YOUR IRA

If you are 70½ or older you can donate up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA. Call distribution or stock your IRA provider and request a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) check payable to Park Lake Presbyterian Church. Have the check mailed to you to put in the offering plate or mailed to the church at 309 East Colonial Drive Orlando, Florida, 32801, attention Financial Administrator.

The QCD is not deductible; however, it is <u>excluded from taxable income</u>, which <u>reduces your adjusted gross income (AGI)</u>. AGI affects Social Security benefits and Medicare premiums. You do not have to itemize to make a QCD donation. If you are 72 or older, the charitable distribution can count toward your Required Minimum Distribution.
