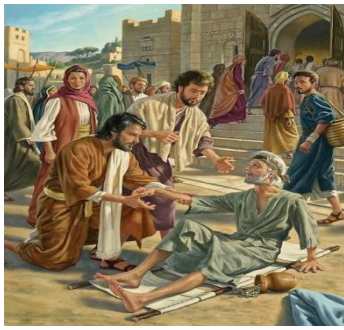

Bible Story
